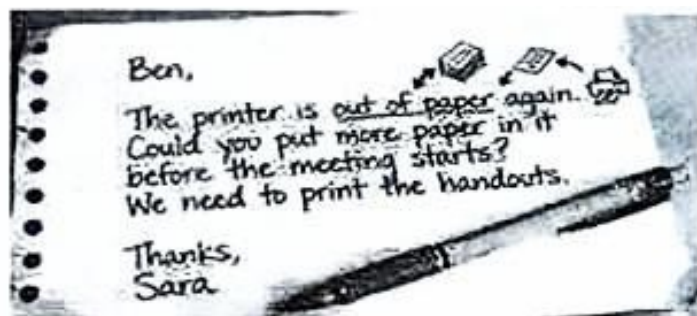

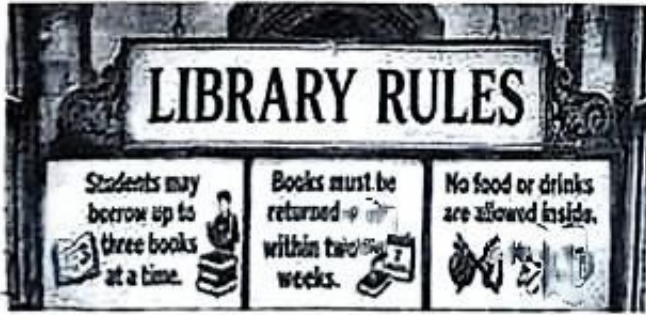

GIẢI CHI TIẾT THAM KHẢO

Part 1

1. announcement

Câu: *This is an announcement about the English-Speaking Club meeting...*

“announcement” là thông báo, phù hợp với nội dung thông báo về buổi họp câu lạc bộ.

2. prepare

Câu: *Each member should prepare a short two-minute talk...*

“prepare a talk” nghĩa là chuẩn bị một bài nói.

3. camera

Câu: *please bring a small camera if you want to take photos...*

Vì phía sau có “take photos” nên dùng “camera”.

4. improve

Câu: *you will improve your confidence and communication skills.*

“improve” nghĩa là cải thiện, nâng cao.

Part 2

5. Chọn D. Something for sun protection and sitting.

Trong thiệp ghi: *Bring a hat and something to sit on!*

“a hat” dùng để chống nắng, “something to sit on” là thứ để ngồi.

6. Chọn D. Add paper to the printer soon.

Sara viết: *The printer is out of paper again. Could you put more paper in it...?*

Nghĩa là máy in hết giấy, Sara nhờ Ben cho thêm giấy vào máy in.

7. Chọn B. Students can keep library books for fourteen days.

Biển ghi: *Books must be returned within two weeks.*

“two weeks” = 14 ngày, nên học sinh có thể giữ sách trong 14 ngày.

Part 3

8. Chọn C. was doing

Câu có “came home last night while...”, hành động đang xảy ra trong quá khứ dùng quá khứ tiếp diễn.

→ *while his wife was doing the housework.*

9. Chọn B. on

Cấu trúc: **be keen on + V-ing**: thích, say mê làm gì.

→ *keen on watching football*

10. Chọn A. mine

Câu cần đại từ sở hữu: *The old one over there is mine.*

“mine” = của tôi.

11. Chọn C. Good luck!

John nói: “Mai tôi sẽ thi cuối kì.”

Lời đáp phù hợp là “Chúc may mắn!”

12. Chọn C. the

“the last bus” là chuyến xe buýt cuối cùng, xác định rõ nên dùng “the”.

13. Chọn A. making

Cấu trúc: **make mistakes**: mắc lỗi.

→ *afraid of making mistakes*

14. Chọn B. creative

Sau mạo từ “a” và trước danh từ “way” cần tính từ.

→ *in a creative way*

15. Chọn C. although

Câu có đủ chủ ngữ và động từ: *the weather was bad*, nên dùng “although”.

→ *Although the weather was bad...*

16. Chọn D. helping

Cấu trúc: **don't mind + V-ing**.

→ *don't mind helping me*

17. Chọn A. will have

Câu điều kiện loại 1:

If + hiện tại đơn, S + will + V.

→ *If she gets up early, she will have more time...*

18. Chọn D. turn off

“turn off the lights” nghĩa là tắt đèn.

Câu nói về tiết kiệm năng lượng nên phải tắt đèn trước khi rời phòng.

19. Chọn A. doctor

Khi có vấn đề sức khỏe thì nên gặp bác sĩ.

→ *see a doctor*

20. Chọn D. I agree

Ann nói: “Ăn đồ ăn nhanh không tốt.”

Lena nói tiếp: “Nó có thể làm chúng ta thừa cân.”

Vậy Lena đồng ý với Ann.

21. Chọn B. biased

“biased toward one side” nghĩa là thiên vị, nghiêng về một phía.

Câu nói bài báo ban đầu có vẻ cân bằng nhưng kết luận lại thiên lệch.

Part 4

22. Chọn D. Several

Câu: *Several mistakes can become useful lessons...*

“mistakes” là danh từ số nhiều. “Several” phù hợp nghĩa: một vài lỗi sai.

23. Chọn C. who

Câu nói về “young people” là người, cần đại từ quan hệ “who”.

→ *young people who are not successful...*

24. Chọn B. However

Câu trước nói sự tiến bộ có thể chậm và lặng lẽ. Câu sau nói họ trở nên mạnh mẽ hơn. Có ý tương phản nhẹ, dùng “However”.

25. Chọn A. pay

Cụm cố định: **pay attention to**: chú ý đến.

→ *pay attention to feedback*

26. Chọn A. challenging

“challenging tasks” nghĩa là những nhiệm vụ khó khăn, thử thách.
Phù hợp với ý “keep going” và “resilience”.

Part 5

27. Chọn A. hour

“hour” có âm **h** câm, đọc là /'aʊə/.
Các từ “hand”, “harm”, “home” đều phát âm âm /h/.

28. Chọn D. bike

“bike” có âm /aɪ/.
Các từ “list”, “tick”, “link” có âm /ɪ/.

Part 6

29. Chọn B. balloon

“balloon” nhấn âm 2: ba**LOON**.
Các từ “hobby”, “teacher”, “student” nhấn âm 1.

30. Chọn C. wonderful

“wonderful” nhấn âm 1: **WON**derful.
Các từ “exciting”, “attractive”, “historic” thường nhấn âm 2.

31. Chọn C. Tiny Bedroom Gardens: A Small Hobby with Quiet Benefits for Teens

Bài đọc nói về việc thanh thiếu niên trồng cây nhỏ trong phòng ngủ và những lợi ích như giúp bình tĩnh, nghỉ khỏi màn hình, rèn sự kiên nhẫn.
Tiêu đề C bao quát đúng nhất.

32. Chọn B. quieter

“calmer” nghĩa là bình tĩnh hơn, yên bình hơn.
Gần nghĩa nhất là “quieter”.

33. Chọn D. plant

Câu: *They need to check the soil, add water, and move the plant if it needs more light.*
“it” thay cho “the plant”.

34. Chọn D. They continue with their work.

Bài đọc viết: *many teenagers do not give up. They simply try again with a stronger plant.*
Vậy khi cây chết, nhiều bạn không bỏ cuộc mà tiếp tục thử lại.

35. Chọn A. Some teens fail at first, but they may continue and learn patience.

Đúng với nội dung: một số cây chết, nhưng nhiều bạn vẫn thử lại; sở thích này dạy sự kiên nhẫn và chăm sóc.

Part 8

36.

It's a pity that I don't have time to take some extra courses.
→ **I wish I had time to take some extra courses.**

Giải thích: Diễn tả điều ước trái với hiện tại:
S + wish + S + V quá khứ đơn

37.

It took him two days to finish the report.

→ **He spent two days finishing the report.**

Giải thích:

It takes/took + someone + time + to V

= Someone spends/spent + time + V-ing

38.

The store near my house is more crowded than this shopping mall.

→ **This shopping mall isn't as crowded as the store near my house.**

Giải thích: So sánh hơn chuyển sang so sánh ngang phủ định:

A is more adj than B

= B isn't as adj as A.

39.

"The cleaners are working on the ground floor now." said the boy.

→ **The boy said that the cleaners were working on the ground floor then.**

Giải thích: Câu tường thuật lùi thì:

"are working" → "were working"

"now" → "then".

40.

Everyone stood up when she walked into the room.

→ **Everyone rose to their feet when she walked into the room.**

Giải thích:

"stand up" = "rise to one's feet": đứng dậy.
